In Greece, their vineyards are trained to grow very short to survive the zephyr winds. Too tall and the vines would break or be blown over. It is said that Zephyrus brings the spring winds, which starts the growing season. Therefore the winds bring what is needed for a successful wine grape harvest in the fall.

Zephyrus' winds also blew ships towards the coast of Greece, encouraging trade in ancient days. This trade allowed for a more prosperous economy and diversified goods to be brought to this coastline-rich part of the world.

BUBBLES

Lovo | Millesimato DOC Prosecco \$11/42

Lovo Prosecco is clean and bright, with lively, small bubbles that lift aromas of citrus, flint, and fresh-cut flowers to the nose.

Millesimato, Italy non-vintage

Casteller | Cava Brut Metodo Tradicional \$12/45

Made in the Traditional Method, this gem from Catalonia exhibits green apple and citrus aromas. In the mouth, it has crisp, fresh flavors with citrus-lime notes and just a touch of sweetness. Thanks to being fermented in the bottle and aged for 12 months on the lees, it tastes fresh, clean and nervy.

Schramsberg | Mirabelle Brut Rosé \$14/55

The Mirabelle Brut Rosé is a specially crafted blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from Schramsberg's select cool-climate vineyards in Carneros, Anderson Valley, and the Sonoma and Marin coastal areas of Northern California. Pinot Noir lots, including a few fermented with skin contact, provide brightness of berry fruit and body, while Chardonnay lots lend length and zest to the palate. Upon first sip, flavors of juicy red apple, pineapple, and orange lead into a lively and delicious finish on the palate.

Blend: 54% Chardonnay, 46% Pinot Noir

Schramsberg | Blanc de Blanc \$15/60

The Schramsberg style of Blanc de Blancs is dry and crisp. Small lots of barrel fermented wines, some of which complete malolactic fermentation, are added to stainless-steel fermented wines to create added complexity in the blended base wine. After undergoing a second fermentation in bottle, the wine ages on its yeast lees for two years prior to disgorgement. With its vibrant, fruitful and focused nature, this sparkling wine will maintain its freshness, structure and refined finish for many years, even decades following its initial release.

Lovo | Prosecco DOC Rose Brut \$11/42

This artisanal Rose Brut boasts beautiful notes of lilac, raspberry, dried mint, and crushed gravel. The color is sunset- perfect - bright and delicate. Hard to imagine a more quaffable aperitif! Perfect with oysters, smoked salmon, and gourmet cheese

Millesimato, Italy non-vintage

Albert Boxler | Cremant D'Alsace Brut \$14/55

If wine can have the power of transportation, here is your ticket to Alsace. Open a bottle of Albert Boxler's Crémant and immerse yourself in the region's abundant natural beauty and quaint, charming villages. This sparkling wine, from a fervent ambassador of long-standing local tradition, is produced in the méthode champenoise before being aged for two years to reveal aromas of bready, toasty notes combined with fresh lemon and tangerine. Bracing acidity, light but persistent effervescence, and wet slate minerality (as usual) from the Alsace.

Fourny & Fils | Champagne Premier Cru \$100

This blend of 80% Chardonnay and 20% Pinot Noir sees partial barrel aging, partial malolactic fermentation, and two and a half years aging in bottle before release. The result is a sleek, elegant Champagne that has roundness along with the astonishing freshness and finesse that are characteristic of all Fourny wines.

WHITE BY THE GLASS

Erste & Neue | Sauvignon Blanc \$12/42

The Sauvignon Blanc shines bright golden with platinum reflexes in the glass. Aromas of green apple, gooseberry and lime go along with a fine acidity to give this Sauvignon Blanc an extra kick on the palate.

Alto Adige, Italy 2022

Coquerel | Sauvignon Blanc \$14/55

The fresh bouquet opens with orange marmalade, kumquat and a hint of vanilla. The palate opens with zingy acidity followed by a creamy mid-palate and a long finish with grapefruit and guava. While it drinks beautifully now, this is one of those rare Sauvignon Blancs that will continue to improve with age.

Sauvignon Blanc | Merry Edwards \$16/60

The stunning 2022 Merry Edwards Sauvignon Blanc is the result of impeccable farming along with their practices of barrel fermentation and lees-stirring. This wine opens with enticing aromas of Meyer lemon, white pineapple, lime zest and white blossoms. On the palate, ripe yellow stone fruit and lemon grass mingle with notes of honeydew and marzipan. The texture is silky, but the bright acidity keeps the wine fresh and lively.

78% Sauvignon Blanc, 22% Sémillon Russian River Valley, CA

Sur Le Fort | Sancerre \$14/55

Exotic nose with notes of mango, honey and spices. Ample, almost mellow, mouthfeel, balanced on the edge by a slight sparkle of acidity which brings peps to the whole. Spicy yet smooth finish.

Rainstorm | Pinot Gris \$10/46cf

Sitting on 153 acres of organic vineyards in the Pfalz region, Reichsrat von Buhl like dry wines. Really dry wines. This is how this wine smells and tastes! Stone fruits and citrus, minerality and freshness.

Sierra Foothills, 2022

Domaine La Patience | Chardonnay \$10/46cf

A refreshing everyday Chardonnay. Pale yellow in the glass with a tart, fruity nose and dynamic mineral scents. The palate opens with crisp citrus and peach flavors that are boosted by vibrant acidity and heady minerality.

Klinker Brick | Albarino \$11/40

A unique varietal suited to the pinot grigio and sauvignon blanc drinker alike, this Albarino is bright with fresh acid, perfect for hot days by the pool and perfectly paired with any seafood dish. Once in the glass you will notice strikingly floral aromas with hints of lychee. A mid palate richness and mouth watering acidity enhance flavors of white stone fruit, fleshy peach and spring melon flavors. The finish is clean with notes of lemon and apricot.

Do Ferreira | Albariño Rias Baixas \$12/42

Do Ferreira is a benchmark Albariño. Every year, it delivers the goods, showing a degree of aromatic complexity, nervy minerality, and pure intensity of flavor that always makes it stand out from the rest. Delicious upon release, it is also one of the few Albariños to improve in bottle for up to a decade (maybe longer?) beyond the vintage year. There is bright fruit intermingling with the classic Do Ferreira salty/smoky mineral bite.

Laird | Pinot Grigio **\$12/42**

Tempting aromas of tropical starburst candy, key lime pie, and elderflower lead the way to an exciting palate filled with flavors of lychee fruit, honeydew melon, and juicy white nectarine. The dry palate is complemented by refreshing acidity and a delightful finish that lingers on your taste buds.

Cold Ranch Vineyard, Carneros 2022

Reichsrat von Buhl | 'Bone Dry' Riesling **\$14/50**

Sitting on 153 acres of organic vineyards in the Pfalz region, Reichsrat von Buhl like dry wines. Really dry wines. This is how this wine smells and tastes! Stone fruits and citrus, minerality and freshness.

100% Riesling, Germany 2022

Marchetti | Verdicchio **\$11/42**

This low yield Verdicchio is a hallmark of the varietal, with refreshing citrus fruits, playful acidity, and complex minerality. Made only with juice from a gentle half-press, it is precise and lovely with melon flavors. The finish is clean with notes of lemon and apricot.

Monopole | Blanco Seco Rioja **\$12/45**

Tart pear, orchard apples, honeysuckle, orange. Stone, minerals and tropical fruit layered on the palate with a nice weight yet crisp and clean. The Rioja "Alta" sub-zone is influenced by the higher altitudes and Atlantic - ideal for making wines with elegance and finesse.

Tintero | Moscato **\$10/40**

This delectable nectar starts with a heavenly scent of spring wildflowers, fragrant citrus blossoms, and succulently ripe grapes. It is just sweet enough, but not too sweet, while a razor-crisp acidity and tickling spritz cleanse and stimulate the taste buds with each gulp.

Lynmar | Chardonnay **\$16/60**

Attractive butterscotch and vanilla aromas lead to tight fruit flavors and nutty, toasty notes in this full-bodied and well-balanced wine that is at once broad in mouthfeel and nicely braced with tangy acidity.

Laird | Chardonnay, Red Hen Vineyard **\$12/45**

Like a Citrine stone, this wine catches your eye with its color and is immediately followed by dreamy aromas of white peach, citrus blossom, raw honey, and brioche. The dry palate has zesty acidity that is complemented by distinct flavors of mango, sweet pear, nectarine, and vanilla. The creamy mouthfeel is followed by a lingering buttery finish. Enjoy on its own or pair with a spread of adventurous cheeses.

Oak Knoll, Napa Valley, 2021

Baglio di Grisi | Chardonnay **\$12/45**

Among the green hills of Western Sicily, the Di Lorenzo family has been cultivating Chardonnay for over thirty years. The winery was one of the first to experiment with this grape variety in Sicily, where it has found ideal soil and climate conditions. This golden yellow wine with greenish highlights is made from a careful selection of bunches of grapes. Aria is a fruity wine characterized by intense aromatic notes. The crispness and flavor on the palate, accompanied by lingering persistence, make this a captivating wine.

De Wetshof Bon Vallon | Chardonnay **\$15/56**

The De Wet family history can be traced back to 1694 when they first landed on the Cape of South Africa. Soils rich in limestone and broken mountain rock on De Wetshof's site-specific vineyards allow this wine to emit optimum varietal expression. An unwooded wine, Bon Vallon has a brisk and clean freshness leading into a wide spectrum of classic flavors including citrus, wild flowers and grilled nuts, with a nuanced minerality on the aftertaste.

Plaimont | Saint-Mont Les Cépage **\$16/60**

Pale yellow with gold inflections, the nose is exotic with honeyed apricot, white peach, and green herbs like lemongrass and cilantro. This medium-full body wine is driven by flavors of ripe apricot, peach, and wild herbs, which is simultaneously buttery, and fresh and zippy, This wine from the gorgeous (but lesser known) Saint- Mont AOC in Gascogne (SW France), is a mouthwatering trio of rare grapes dating back to Roman times. Facing extinction, André Dubosc (a third-generation wine grower) set out in the 1970s to build up and preserve the vines from this special region. The small sub-alpine pocket is 50 miles from the Pyrénées Mountains and just over the border from Basque country.

Folk Machine | White Light **\$40**

Fresh with acid and some mineral, this wine retains that sort of salty, briny character Tocai Friulano is known for, but tones it down with the fruit and aromatics of Riesling and Verdelho, with added leanness from the Sauvignon Blanc.

Domaine du Salvard Le Petit Salvard **\$45**

This vibrant and crisp Sauvignon Blanc from the Loire Valley is bright and clear with LV signature flavors of gooseberries, lime, grapefruit and lemon, with a touch of fresh green herbs and wet stone. A perfect pairing with goat cheese!

WHITE BY THE BOTTLE

Ghost Block | Sauvignon Blanc **\$45**

This Single Vineyard wine from Yountville opens with pronounced aromas that waft immediately from the glass with just-ripe peaches, lemon, grapefruit, and honeydew with subtle notes of jasmine.

La Follette | ZEPHYR CHARDONNAY **\$80**

Fruity and refreshing, this well-balanced and medium-bodied wine offers mouth filling Golden Apple and Bosc Pear flavors backed by lively acidity and mild notes of vanilla and butter. Greg La Follette is one of Sonoma County's most notable winemakers and consultants. He's known for consulting at Kendall-Jackson, La Crema, DeLoach, and helped establish the world-famed Flowers Vineyard and Winery.

Aperture | Chenin Blanc **\$40**

This Chenin Blanc is among the most profound in California, and the incredible soil is a big reason why. Because the Chenin vines sink their roots deep into Clarksburg's clay-loam soils, they have the opportunity to pull power and presence from deep within the earth. Combine that with the "Delta Breeze" that sweeps in from the San Francisco Bay, allowing the fruit to ripen fully and at a perfectly leisurely pace, It's a vibrant and bright wine, coming from old vines planted in the 1940's.

From the first vineyard purchased outside of Burgundy, France by Iconic winemakers from Maison Louis Jadot, this gem is sourced from both estate vineyards and top vineyards in the Willamette Valley. This wine showcases the absolute best of the Willamette Valley and elegantly blends Maison Louis Jadot's wine making history with the Willamette Valley's signature terroir. A wine with a bright golden color and a delicate nose of lemon blossom, jasmine, orange peel, and vanilla. The palate is fresh and vibrant, with beautiful balance and a crisp finish.

The Domaine Tour Saint Michel has been a family estate since 1930. Using 100% organic practices, the vines cover 35 hectares in the appellation Chateauneuf-du-Pape.

Lynmar, Quail Hill Vineyards | Chardonnay \$75

Located on their home estate, Quail Hill Vineyard has long been recognized as a gem in the region. This flagship Chardonnay offers Jasmine, Orange Cream, Sea Breeze, White Peach on the nose and flavors of Baked Pear, Dried Fig, and Honeysuckle. Aged 14 months in oak, this wine offers the round buttery flavor.

ROSÉ

Klinker Brick | Rosé of Pinot Noir \$10/46cf

Mouthwatering notes of strawberry guava, and a hint of grapefruit lead into a crisp and refreshing texture on the palate. True to Klinker Brick style, this wine retains an exceptional balance of freshness and aromatics, while still providing the dry finish that makes it a perfect pairing for roast chicken, goat cheese, or mixed greens with strawberries.

Jax Y3 | Rose of Pinot Noir \$10/36

As eternal rosé lovers, the Jax winemaking team have always wanted to craft a gem of their own. The key to such a creation would be the ideal vineyard which we found on the Sonoma Coast. With minimal skin contact, this delicate rosé offers a bone-dry style accompanied by a touch of weight and complexity. Think "lunch in Provence."

Browne Family Vineyards | Rosé \$10/40

Medium-bodied, with lively acidity, this pink is for the raspberry fans. A raspberry Italian soda aroma is joined by notes of spearmint and grilled apricots. Raspberries reappear on the creamy palate in the form of pastille candies to accompany a pronounced Thai basil note.

Yves Leccia | Rosé \$14/52

This rosé from the French island of Corsica delivers juicy pomelo and a crisp and bracing acidity that is puckery, grippy, and impossibly fresh. Highlighting the clay and limestone soil of the area, Corsican beauté is clean, citrusy, and saline—organically grown, to boot.

Domaine de Fontaine | Rosé \$14/52

Grenache Gris is a pink-skinned, more characterful version of Grenache Blanc that ripens into a bouquet of fresh nectarine, white cherries, and bergamot. The pale juice released from gently pressing the grapes immediately after harvest preserves the fruit's delicate aromas and transforms into a delicious rosé, purely and simply. The domaine's vineyards happen to be situated in the remote "Golden Crescent" area of Les Corbières. Flanked by a pine forest that protects from harsh winds, this pristine, sun-drenched region benefits from Mediterranean sea breezes and a gravelly soil with large, polished stones that regulate temperature. Winemaker, Bruno Laboucarié says "In the early morning, while the air is still humid, there is this perfume of pine resin and rock roses, of rosemary and thyme, and aromatic heather that warms up above the vineyard." Every scent that Bruno describes shows up in the glass, which makes his approach to winegrowing crystal-clear: great wine is made in the vineyard and there are no tricks or shortcuts!

Château de Trinou Vide Rosé \$35

Raspberry color, with a soft clearness and deep purple highlights, this rosé from the Tavel region of France is romantic, yet complex. It offers wisps of orange blossom aromas with generous scents of blackcurrant, strawberry, raspberry and, slight aniseed. Complex, intense, full-bodied, mineral, structured body, long length. Pair with fish dishes, white meats, poultry.

REDS BY THE GLASS

Di Arie | Vineyards Barbera \$11/48cf

This wine has very distinctive cherry, plum and blackberry aromas with flavors of cranberry and pomegranate and well balanced acidity. The wine shows good structure and complexity in the mid-palate and has a lingering finish of coffee and anise.

Clos La Coutale | Malbec \$12/44

From the spiritual home of Malbec, this Cahors is earthy and spicy. This blend of mostly Malbec and a splash of Merlot shows a floral nose with rich and rustic fruit. It is a full bodied wine with structure and balance. A great example of old world Malbec to pair with meats and stews.

Chateau Musar | Jeune Red \$14/44

Founded by Gaston Hochar in 1930, Chateau Musar is Lebanon's premier estate. Only hand-picked estate fruit is used and the wines are minimally handled, allowing for natural fermentation with very little sulfur, or filtering. A deep plum with violet rim in the glass, the nose bursts with blueberries, dark red cherries, Mediterranean herbs, tobacco and spice. On the palate this is a warm and fruity wine with dense, dark fruits such as black currant, blueberries, strawberries and pomegranate, finishing with medium tannins, gentle acidity, and a touch of Eastern spice.

Macedon | Pinot Noir \$12/44

From the country of North Macedonia, this stunning Pinot is named for Alexander the Great (the original "Macedon"), and hails from an area known as the cross-roads of the ancient world. Sharing the same latitude band as Burgundy and Russian River, the 40+ year old vines grow where two major weather fronts collide, yielding virtually no rain. The result is a wine of terrific elegance and complexity, rich yet linear; pretty, but with power. A phenomenal value.

Jax Y3 Pinot Noir | Pinot Noir \$12/44

CEO Dan Parrott, had worked with some of the best producers in Burgundy before jumping on board at JAX, and it was Dan who inspired us to find the ideal vineyard to achieve a killer pinot! This fruit is hand-harvested into small bins in the early morning to protect the fruit and preserve freshness. Grapes are hand sorted and partially de-stemmed before going into small open top fermenters. Following a 5-7 day cold soak period and 10-12 day fermentation the wine is aged in French oak barrels.

Russian River, CA 2019

Lynmar Estate | Pinot Noir \$16/60

A brilliant rose color in the glass, this wine exudes juicy aromatics of baked strawberry, dragon fruit and cherry cola. A focused but generous entry on the palate leads way to tastes of cherry juice, ripe red plum and baking spice culminating in lively tannins and a persistent finish.

Saintsbury | Pinot Noir \$20/80

This single vineyard wine is red-fruit driven, featuring ripe raspberries and fresh strawberries with a pretty hint of vanilla and cinnamon. On the first sip, this wine is bright and buoyed by refreshing acidity, followed by a persistent core of tannins that brings elegant texture. Hints of yellow fruit skin and gravel give way to a slightly spicy finish highlighted by notes of blood orange and cherry cola.

Sundawg Ridge Vineyard, Russian River Valley, CA 2021

Klinker Brick | Old Vine Zinfandel \$11/48cf

Full, juicy flavors of cherries and plums coupled with the perfect balance of oak and spice. There is a nuance of mint and clove on the nose and a lingering, elegant finish. This wine was aged in American oak for 15 months.

Easton | Zinfandel **\$14/50**

Bill Easton is one of the pioneers of Amador's modern winemaking era, founding his winery in 1984, and his wines still lead the pack in terms of quality. Long renowned as one of the best places in the world for distinctive Zinfandel because of its old head-pruned vines, mountain soils, languid blue sky days, and cool summer nights, this wine is big but well-balanced, offering plenty of luscious ripe berries and plums along with hints of black pepper and sage. Moderate tannins seem to build on the palate and add a good bite to the finish.

Amador County 2016

Jax Vineyards Y3 Taureau Red Blend **\$14/50**

The name "Taureau" was the name of the Jackson family's prized bull, legendary for his feisty, high-kicking and vibrant personality. When perfecting this wine at their blending session, the JAX team concurred that the complex personality of their infamous bull reflected the complex structure and elements of this indulgent red blend. Reflecting the dominating character of Taureau, this wine boasts incredible purple fruit colors, flavors of blackberry, black cherry and red on the palate, and all supported by polished tannins.

Di Arie | Cabernet Sauvignon **\$11/48cf**

Every component has been individually crafted and aged in French oak barrels for 2 years. The wine has a ruby color with strong blackberry aromas, which carry to the palate adding hints of chocolate and spice. The finish is long with a firm but delightful grip of tannins.

Merry Edwards | Olivet Lane Pinot Noir \$95

Olivet Lane Pinot Noir was the first vineyard-designated wine produced under the Merry Edwards label back in 1997. This is a classically elegant Russian River Pinot Noir with aromas of cherries, violets and fresh strawberries along with subtle earthy notes of forest floor and mushroom. The entry is round and lush, balanced on the palate — overall a well-structured wine supported by oak. A dusting of pretty brown spice and a hint of cream soda linger on the finish. Given some time in the bottle, this elegant and engaging wine will continue to develop for years to come.

Laird | Merlot \$75

Suscol Ranch vineyard is located in southeast Napa Valley. The south-facing vineyard provides even sun exposure for the ripening of the grapes, and this easy-drinking Merlot has black fruit notes on the front of the palate and an undertone of vanilla on the finish. The deep ruby color is followed by an equally beautiful bouquet of boysenberry, violets, pepper, and sap. Flavors of bramble, sweet, dried cherry, and sage are complemented by chewy tannins, lively acid, and a lingering finish. Drink now through 2028.

Canard Vineyard | Cabernet Sauvignon \$80

Dry farming creates intensely concentrated fruit with more complexity, richness and character than an irrigated grape. However very few vineyards in Napa still use these traditional methods today due to the low yield. It takes great sacrifice to make great wine. On the nose hints of black cherry, sage, elderflower and red raspberry. The aromas lead to a soft entry with hints of vanilla, dark chocolate and red currants. Gentle tannins give the single vineyard wine great structure and create an accessible yet age worthy wine. Cellar for 15+ years.

The wine has a deep garnet hue that leads to a captivating spice and dark berry aroma. It expresses a range of enticing flavors including ripe blackberry, yellow plum, black tea, elderberry, and roasted coffee bean.

2020 Cabernet Franc comes from a Vineyard in Oakville harvested in the third week of September. The wine is very powerful and dark with an earthy leafy nose, with a hint of toast. Banfi | ASKA Bolgheri Rosso \$80

Produced with a selection of Cabernet Sauvignon with a small percentage of Cabernet Franc from highly specialized vineyards. A gorgeous deep ruby red in the glass with violet reflections. On the nose are ripe red berries, blueberries and plum jam, followed by hints of tobacco and licorice. On the palate this wine is well rounded with velvety tannins and a persistent finish.

Banfi | Brunello di Montalcino \$110

A rich and elegant Brunello, this wine from famous producer, Banfi, is brilliant ruby red with garnet-colored reflections. Aromas are sweet and fruity, and the hints of fresh red fruit stand out, which combine perfectly with the more complex notes of licorice and pipe tobacco. The structure is powerful, and the palate is pleasantly enveloped by a consistent tannic texture, well balanced by a pleasant acidity. Extremely persistent with excellent aging potential.

Domaine Tour Saint-Michel | Chateauneuf Du Pape Rouge \$85

This Domaine is located in the sunniest and warmest part of the appellation, and the terroir is pure rocks and stones. The juice is all aged in concrete and delivers a classic, peppery, and savory cherry-driven wine with ripe tannins and a great finish.

Chateau Musar | Red \$90

Seven years in the making, Chateau Musar Red is an equal blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Carignan and Cinsault from vineyards near the Bekaa Valley villages of Aana and Kefraya on gravelly soils over limestone. The 2016 vintage is deep ruby in color with high viscosity. Red cherries, plums, carob and figs dominate the nose with a hint of eastern spice. Kirsch and plums follow through to the palate with blackcurrant and chocolate. The tannins are velvety soft and this wine has a lot of depth and fruit concentration with a long finish.

Made from 100% Muscat à Petits Grains Blanc and crafted in the traditional a vin doux naturel style. The wine is a pure delight with the distinctive Muscat flavors of peach, apricot, lychee fruit and honey. Among the last producers to use this old-fashioned method of vinification, the spirits are kept as low as possible, so that bright freshness in the grapes shines through. One can find more powerful Muscats, but none as tasty and fine., Finesse with a certain elegance. The perfect dessert wine but also delicious with foie gras, melon and Roquefort cheese.

Rhône Valley

Broadbent Auction Reserve Port

\$16/56

The pretty pomegranate red hue provides a look into the heart of this Port. Light and fragrant violets and lavender are bolstered by the aromas of sweet blackberry and anise. There is also a whiff of spirit that is noticeable but does not detract. Broadbent's Auction Reserve offers a smooth, medium-bodied Port that delivers fresh, fruit-forward boysenberry and plum flavors with a nice touch of chocolate that adds to the overall enjoyment of this wine. The tannins let you know they have shown up to the party, without being obtrusive. Delivers a lingering and fruit filled finish.
